Dear Mr Ioannides,

Thank you for your letter of 14/11/2016 [Ref.Ares(2016)640436] providing our services further information regarding:

- a. The definition of values for result indicator T4907 (*"percentage of students carrying out internships in companies"*) under investment priority 10.iv (49% baseline and 55% target value).
- b. The operation of the monitoring systems that are in place for result indicators:
 - i. T4901 (*"number of schools that reduced early school leaving by 20% at least"*) under investment priority 10.i, and
